



## English Transfer Program

Students who complete an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree at Southern State Community College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in English at Wright State University. Students may choose a contrarian in Creative Writing, Language Arts Education, Literature, and Professional Writing, or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA degree requirements.


### Admission Requirements to the English Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA (or 2.5 for Language Arts Education),
2. Grade of "C" or higher in ENG 1100 equivalency (ENG 1101 at Southern State), and
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities and/or Social Sciences.
