Organizational Leadership

Students who complete an associate degree at Southern State Community College may transfer into the B.S. in Organizational Leadership at Wright State University. By completing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree, students will have completed the Ohio Transfer Module and thus have met the general education requirements of the Wright State Core as long as they have taken the required Microeconomics and Statistics. Students graduating with an applied degree will have to complete additional courses to complete the Wright State Core.

If possible, students should complete the following courses at Southern State:

1. ECON 2205, Microeconomics (Equivalent to EC 2040)
2. MATH 1160, Elementary Statistics (Equivalent to STT 1600)

Admission Requirements to the Organizational Leadership Program at Wright State

1. Conferred associate's degree

or

1. 60 semester credits earned
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
3. Completed STT 1600 (or equivalent), OL 2010, and OL 3020
