Students who complete an Associate of Arts (A.A) degree at Southern State Community College may transfer into the Bachelor of Science (B.S) or the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Psychology at Wright State University.

In addition to the A.A degree, students may complete additional coursework at Southern State to apply to the B.S. or B.A. in Psychology at Wright State. Appropriate courses are suggested in the concluding portion of this document. Students should verify their satisfactory academic program (SAP) requirements with the Office of Financial Aid before pursuing classes outside of the A.A. degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the Psychology Program at Wright State

1. 20 semester hours earned
2. Complete introduction to psychology with grade of at least a C
3. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.25
