

PERMISSION FOR TRANSIENT STATUS

To be granted permission for transient status, you must complete and submit, in addition to this form, a non-degree application form and a \$10 application fee. Transcripts are not required since the signature of the dean of graduate studies at the college/university you are attending will assist in establishing your eligibility for graduate study at Wright State. This form should be returned to the address given below. You will not be permitted to register for graduate credit at Wright State University until the Graduate School receives this form with the appropriate signature and seal and notifies you of your acceptance. Transient status is granted for one semester only but may be extended by reapplication.

Eligibility for Transient Status:

**You must be pursuing a graduate degree (active status) at another regionally accredited institution
You must be in good standing (3.0 or above graduate grade point average) in your graduate program.**

You intend to complete your graduate program at the institution in which you are currently enrolled

Certain programs/departments may have additional eligibility requirements.
