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- Students must apply for admission to Wright State **and** the Nursing program by May 15 for fall and September 15 for spring admission in their sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Sinclair).
- In order to be admitted fully as a nursing major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.75 with coursework completed within the last 10 years at the time of program admission application).
- Students must earn a C or higher in the following pre-requisite courses while maintaining a minimum pre-requisite GPA of 2.75: BIO 1111 or 1171, BIO 1141, BIO 1242, CHE 1121, ENG 1101, MAT 1450, PSY 1100, and PSY 2200 at Sinclair.
- Students must complete both BIO 1141 and 1242 at Sinclair prior to transferring to Wright State.
- Both BCI and FBI background checks are required for undergraduate students; the background check results must have no criminal record on file.
- Achievement of a minimum composite score of 75 percent on the English language, science, and math modules of the [HESI A2 Entrance Exam](#). This requirement will be waived for students who provide prior evidence of successful completion ("C" or higher) for at least one clinical course (i.e. Nursing Fundamentals) from a regionally accredited institution or accredited through CCNE or ACEN or 2) hold a prior baccalaureate degree.  
See the [Nurses Aid Training and HESI Testing Requirements chart](#) to determine the need for HESI testing.
- 120 hours minimum are required for a BSN degree at Wright State.

# 1. ADMISSIONS AND DEADLINES

### *Join the Wright Path Program*

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at [wright.edu/wrightpath/sinclair](http://wright.edu/wrightpath/sinclair).

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High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Sinclair College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

## ***Transfer to Wright State University***

Students must apply for admission to Wright State **and** the Nursing program by May 15 for fall and September 15 for spring admission in their sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Sinclair).

In order to be admitted fully as a nursing major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.75 with coursework completed within the last 10 years at the time of program admission application).

Students must earn a C or higher in the following pre-requisite courses while maintaining a minimum pre-requisite GPA of 2.75: BIO 1111 or 1171, BIO 1141, BIO 1242, CHE 1121, ENG 1101, MAT 1450, PSY 1100, and PSY 2200 at Sinclair.

Students must complete both BIO 1141 and 1242 at Sinclair prior to transferring to Wright State.

Both BCI and FBI background checks are required for undergraduate students; the background check results must have no criminal record on file.

Achievement of a minimum composite score of 75 percent on the English language, science, and math modules of the [HESI A2 Entrance Exam](#). This requirement will be waived for students who provide prior evidence of successful completion ("C" or higher) for at least one clinical course (i.e. Nursing Fundamentals) from a regionally accredited institution or accredited through CCNE or ACEN or 2) hold a prior baccalaureate degree. See the [Nurses Aid Training and HESI Testing Requirements chart](#) to determine the need for HESI testing.
