## Environmental Health & Safety Bleacher Inspection Policy

### I. Purpose

To ensure all university bleachers and folding/telescopic seating are inspected in accordance with ICC 300-2007, Standard for Bleachers, Folding and Telescopic Seating and Grandstands as required in the Ohio Fire Code (Ohio Administrative Code 1301:7-7-10).

## II. Scope

This policy applies to all Wright State University owned bleachers/telescopic seating including, but not limited to, Alumni Field, the WSU Softball field, the Nutter Center, and Lake Campus.

#### III. Definitions

- **A. Bleachers** Tiered seating supported on a dedicated structural system being two or more rows high.
- **B.** Folding/Telescopic Seating Tiered seating capable of being reduced in size and shape for moving or storing.

## IV. Responsibilities

#### A. Environmental Health and Safety

- 1. Ensure inspections are completed as required.
- **2.** Maintain copies of all inspection reports.
- **3.** Coordinate with the IUC Loss Control Committee for inclusion in the group purchasing program for annual bleacher inspection services.

## B. Responsible Party/Owning Department of Bleacher/Folding/Telescopic Seating

- 1. Coordinate required inspections with the service provider contracted through the IUC purchasing program on an annual basis.
- 2. Maintain inspection reports and forward copies to EHS.

## V. Procedures

**A.** Construction of new temporary, permanent, or rental bleachers, folding and telescopic seating and grandstands shall be in compliance with ICC 300-2007, Chapters 1 through 4.

- **B.** All existing seating shall be inspected in accordance with ICC 300-2007, Chapter 5. New installations must comply with entire standard.
- **C.** All seating shall be inspected and evaluated at least once per year by qualified personnel.
- **D.** All folding and telescopic seating shall be inspected to ensure compliance with manufacturer installation and operational instructions, including the opening and closing of this type of seating.

## VI. Training and Recordkeeping

Inspection reports will be kept on file within the department owning the bleachers. Copies of inspection reports are to be forwarded to EHS.
