Pre-Health Sciences students must complete BIO 1510, BIO 1520, CHM 1210, and CHM 1220.
- All students with declared Psychology major are automatically admitted as Pre-Psychology students.
- In order to be admitted fully as a psychology major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0. Additionally, in order to be admitted fully into Behavioral Neuroscience, Clinical Psychology, Cognition and Perception, or Industrial and Organizational Psychology Concentration, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.2.
- Students must earn a C or higher in PSY 1111 at Clark State.

High School students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Clark State College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Clark State College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

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Fall Semester: **April 1**
Spring Semester: **October 15**
Summer Semester: **February 1**

Students must apply to the Undergraduate Admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Clark State College.

In order to be admitted fully as a psychology major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0. Additionally, in order to be admitted fully into Behavioral Neuroscience, Clinical Psychology, Cognition and Perception, or Industrial and Organizational Psychology Concentration, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.2.

Behavioral Neuroscience students must choose either BIO 1510 and 1520 or CHM 1210 and 1220 for the Ohio Transfer 36 Natural Science requirement at Clark State. Clinical Psychology students must choose BIO 1510 and 1520 for the Ohio Transfer 36 Natural Sciences requirement at Clark State. General, Cognition/Perception, and Industrial/Organizational students may choose any two Ohio Transfer 36 Natural Sciences courses. Pre-Health Sciences students must complete BIO 1510, BIO 1520, CHM 1210, and CHM 1220.

Students must earn a C or higher in PSY 1111 at Clark State.
