Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Clark State College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester: **April 1**
Spring Semester: **October 15**
Summer Semester: **February 1**

Students must apply for undergraduate admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Clark State College.


