High School students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Clark State College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

### *Transfer to Wright State University*

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Clark State College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester:	<b>April 1</b>
Spring Semester:	<b>October 15</b>
Summer Semester:	<b>February 1</b>

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Students must apply to the Undergraduate Admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Clark State College.

In order to be admitted fully as a biological sciences major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.

Students must earn a C or higher in BIO 2121 or BIO 2122 at Clark State.

Students must earn a C or higher in all science and mathematics courses at Clark State and Wright State.
