- All students with declared Technical and Applied Studies major are automatically admitted as Pre-Technical and Applied Studies students.
- In order to be admitted fully as a technical and applied studies major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENGL 1100 at Columbus State.
- Students must complete three Wright State Core courses from Element B, C, or D.
- 128-131 hours minimum are required for a BTAS degree at Wright State.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Columbus State Community College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

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Fall Semester: **April 1**
Spring Semester: **October 15**
Summer Semester: **February 1**

In order to be admitted fully as a bachelor of technical and applied studies major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0. In addition, students must earn a C or higher in ENGL 1100 at Columbus State and three courses from Ohio Transfer 36 Mathematics, Arts & Humanities, or Social & Behavioral Science.
