II. <u>JOB SUMMARY</u>

Under general direction, supervises Custodial Floor Care staff and/or Custodial operations personnel in all duties pertaining to various floor maintenance functions in accordance with standard techniques and procedures.

- Assigns, supervises and inspects the work of Custodial Floor Care (and/or of a group of custodial workers) staff pertaining to various types of equipment used for floor care maintenance.
- Prioritize and coordinate with other workers to complete floor care work.

- Provides work direction and leadership regarding chemical, supply and equipment.
- Assess projects and determines most efficient methods and equipment to be used.
- Performs administrative duties to include administering directives on personnel actions; reassignments; time cards and attendance records; performance ratings; disciplinary actions and other personnel matters.
- Communicating and enforcing policies and procedures; resolving problems; addressing employee concerns and complaints.
- Directs training and ensures safety requirements are enforced in proper floor care methods and procedures and ensures the use of chemicals is consistent with established safety standards and practices.
- Prepares reports, maintains logs and manages scheduling.
- Responsible for maintaining inventory and ordering supplies.
