- Students must apply for admission to Wright State **and** the Nursing program by May 15 for fall and September 15 for spring admission in their sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Edison State).
- In order to be admitted fully as a nursing major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.75 with coursework completed within the last 10 years at the time of program admission application).
- Students must earn a C or higher in the following pre-requisite courses while maintaining a minimum pre-requisite GPA of 2.75: BIO 121S, BIO 125S, BIO 126S, CHM111S, ENG 121S, MTH 125S, PSY 121S, and PSY 227S at Edison State.
- Students must complete both BIO 125S and 126S at Edison State prior to transferring to Wright State.
- Both BCI and FBI background checks are required for undergraduate students; the background check results must have no criminal record on file.
- Achievement of a minimum composite score of 75 percent on the English language, science, and math modules of the HESI A2 Entrance Exam. This requirement will be waived for students who provide prior evidence of successful completion ("C" or higher) for at least one clinical course (i.e., Nursing Fundamentals) from a regionally accredited institution or accredited through CCNE or ACEN or 2) hold a prior baccalaureate degree.
See the Nurses Aid Training and HESI Testing Requirements chart to determine the need for HESI testing.
- 120 hours minimum are required for a BSN degree at Wright State.

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
