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Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at wright.edu/edisonstate.

High school students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Edison State students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

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
