High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Edison State students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

## ***Transfer to Wright State University***

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester:	<b>April 1</b>
Spring Semester:	<b>October 15</b>
Summer Semester:	<b>February 1</b>

Students must apply for undergraduate admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Edison State.

In order to be admitted fully as a crime and justice studies major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.

Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 121S at Edison State.

Students must complete Cadet Initial Entry Training (CIET), the requirements of Military Science 1010, 1020, 2010, 2020 with a grade of C or better, or Basic Training or other service component basic initial training. Students complete MIL 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020 through SOCHE Cross Registration while studying at Edison State.
