- The MLT transfer guide for the BA in Biological Sciences enables students who are certified (ASCP) MLTs to complete a bachelor's degree, as well as an opportunity to become eligible for the MLS (ASCP) certification exam. To be eligible for this exam, students must be certified as an MLT, obtain a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, and have at least 3 years clinical lab experience within the last 10 years. Experience must be in all areas of the lab.
- In order to be admitted fully as a biological sciences major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.
- Students must earn a C or higher in BIO 126S and 242S at Edison State.
- Students must earn a C or higher in all science courses at Edison State and Wright State.
- 135.5 hours minimum are required for a BA degree at Wright State.

## 1. ADMISSIONS AND DEADLINES

### *Join the Wright Path Program*

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at [wright.edu/edisonstate](http://wright.edu/edisonstate).

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High school students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Edison State students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

## ***Transfer to Wright State University***

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester:	<b>April 1</b>
Spring Semester:	<b>October 15</b>
Summer Semester:	<b>February 1</b>

Students must apply for undergraduate admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Edison State.

In order to be admitted fully as a biological sciences major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.

Students must earn a C or higher in BIO 126S and 242S at Edison State.

Students must earn a C or higher in all science courses at Edison State and Wright State.

The MLT transfer guide for the BA in Biological Sciences enables students who are certified (ASCP) MLTs to complete a bachelor's degree, as well as an opportunity to become eligible for the MLS (ASCP) certification exam. 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


