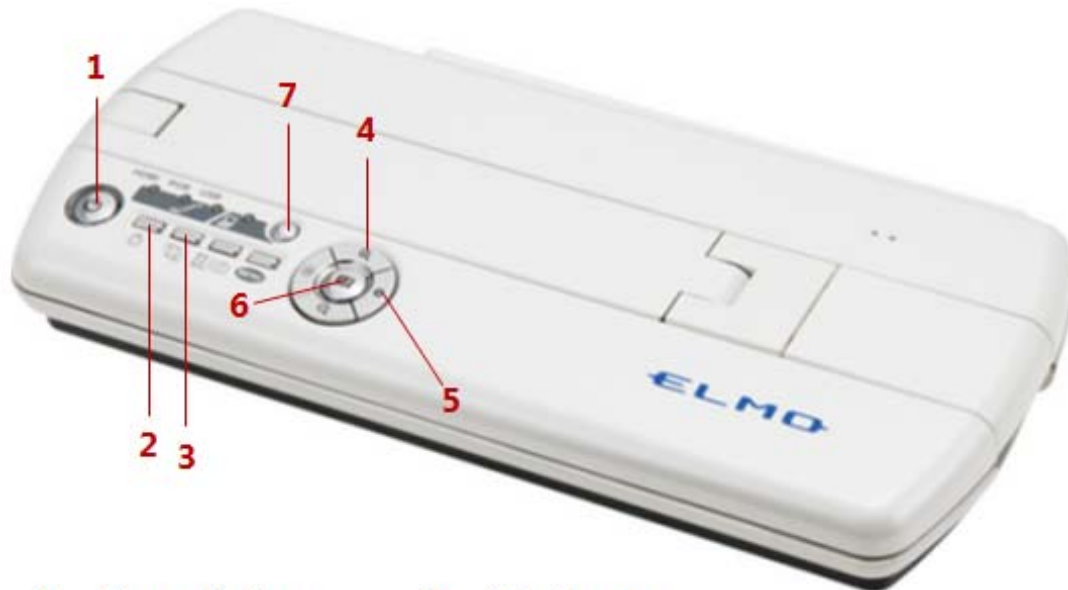


Using the Document Camera

1. TURN THE DOCUMENT CAMERA ON.

- You must wait until the blue ring stops flashing before continuing.

2. TURN ON THE VIDEO PROJECTOR AND SELECT THE DOC CAM INPUT SOURCE.

3. FULLY EXTEND THE CAMERA ARM.

4. USE TOGGLE OUTPUT (#7 above) TO CHANGE FROM HDMI TO RGB MODE.

5. PLACE OBJECT TO BE DISPLAYED UNDER CAMERA.

- If classroom lights are off, press the document light button (#2 above).

6. USE THE ZOOM BUTTON (#4 above) OR AUTO FOCUS (#6 above) TO ADJUST IMAGE.

7. WHEN FINISHED, TURN OFF DOCUMENT CAMERA AND RETURN CAMERA ARM TO CLOSED POSITION.

8. TURN OFF VIDEO PROJECTOR.
