

Using NetSupport School Tutor

NetSupport School Tutor allows the instructor of a course to control all of the student computers within a computer lab or active learning space. Instructors can view the classroom as a whole, or an individual table of computers.

Launching NetSupport School Tutor

1. Launch 'NetSupport School Tutor' using the icon on the desktop.
2. All inactive stations will appear in gray by default.

To Power On Student Computers:

Do not click on an individual computer at this time. By default, all computers are selected.

1. Click on the 'Manage' icon in the toolbar.
2. Select 'Power On'.
3. Computers will turn from gray to green as they turn on.

To Power Off Student Computers:

1. Click on the 'Manage' icon in the toolbar.
2. Select 'Power Off'.
3. Computers will turn from green to gray as they shut down.
