we welcome the following donations:

- APPLIANCES:** Working Washers, Dryers, Refrigerators, Microwaves, and Stoves.
- ARCHITECTURAL ITEMS:** Columns, Mantels, etc.
- CABINETS:** Kitchen and Bathroom Cabinets.
- DOORS:** No broken glass, holes/gouges, water damage, splinters, and not bowed/twisted.
- FLOORING:** Wood, Tile, Vinyl, Carpets, and Pads, 100 square foot minimum.
- FURNITURE:** Upholstered Items, Chairs, Couches, Tables, Bed Sets w/o bedding.
- HARDWARE:** Knobs, Hinges, Locks, Nails, Cabinet Pulls, Bolts, Nuts, Screws.
- LIGHTING FIXTURES & CEILING FANS:** No broken or missing components.
- LUMBER:** Minimal 8' length. No nails, rot, or water damage.
- METAL RECYCLING:** Items made mostly of metal.
- MIRRORS:** Must be framed and in good condition.
- PLUMBING:** Usable fixtures, parts, and supplies. No faucets or soldered copper fittings.
- PLYWOOD:** Sheathing: Half/full sheets.
- TOOLS:** Hand, garden, working power tools.
- WINDOWS:** Complete and usable units. Non-fogged, clear insulated glass.

items we cannot accept:

Any item deemed unsellable in store, bedding or clothing, CRT TV's or stands, faucets, hot tubs, soldered copper fittings, drapes, blinds with slats under .3" or without brackets, landscaping patio and paving stones/bricks, lumber containing nails, paint, pianos or organs, toxic/hazardous or lead based materials or chemicals (lawn, pest, pool, finishing), unframed mirrors.
