AGREEMENT

1. Living in campus housing at Wright State University is an option, not a requirement.
2. The campus housing application and agreement is a full academic year contract. (Fall and Spring semesters)
3. A \$150.00 prepayment is required to complete the application process at www.wright.edu/housing. The prepayment is applied to the first semester's housing fees.
4. Once completed, the housing application becomes a contractual agreement between the student and Residence Life & Housing. A release from the agreement requires the student to participate in an appeals process. There is no guarantee that a release will be approved.
5. On campus room charges vary in range per semester depending on the room type, and include all utility costs. Off campus housing providers do not include utility costs in their agreement.
6. Residence Life & Housing makes every effort to honor students' preferences for housing assignments. It should be understood that assignments are made on a first come, first-serve basis and are dependent upon the availability of existing units.
7. International students may be assigned to a unit with American or other international students.
8. Students may request a change of assignment after moving in. It is recommended that students communicate concerns with a representative of Residence Life & Housing if they experiences problems or difficulties with their assignments.
9. The meal plan is mandatory for residents living the residence halls
