2) Health Insurance Waiver Deadline

Fall 2015 Semester deadline for insurance waiver is by **Friday, September 11, 2015.**

Waivers will be approved only for students who have a U.S. based insurance coverage through the employer of a spouse or parent or students who are sponsored by the government.

Sponsored students should submit financial guarantees to Raider Connect office on or before

Friday, September 11, 2015 and dependent waiver requests should be sent to **Jonathon Henderson** in University Center for International Education (UCIE Office –E190 Student Union).

You must immediately verify in Wings Express that items on your bill are correct and request a waiver if corrections are needed or you will be required to pay for any unchallenged fees after September 12.

8) OPT Instructions for Fall 2015

International students graduating in fall 2015 semester may begin applying for OPT on **September 21, 2015**. The final date for fall 2015 graduates to apply for OPT is **February 5, 2016**.

Choose a start date OPT between 12/20/2015 and 2/18/2016.

PLEASE NOTE: If you have any reservations regarding potential graduation for fall 2015 semester, do not apply for OPT until you are certain about graduation.

11) Authorization as a "Proxy" and an "Authorized User":

Proxy:

What is Student Proxy Access? Students can designate a Proxy (third parties like parents, spouse, employer, etc) to speak with Raider Connect by phone or in person regarding registration (eg. class schedule and grades), billing and financial aid related issues. A Proxy can also be given access to view specific information in WINGS Express related to registration.

How can you add a Proxy? Students can authorize proxy access through WINGS Express. For step-by-step instructions visit <http://www.wright.edu/raider-connect/proxy>

Authorized User:

What is an Authorized User? Students can designate an Authorized User to access specific billing and payment information in the Touchnet system and will receive e-mails related to billing.
