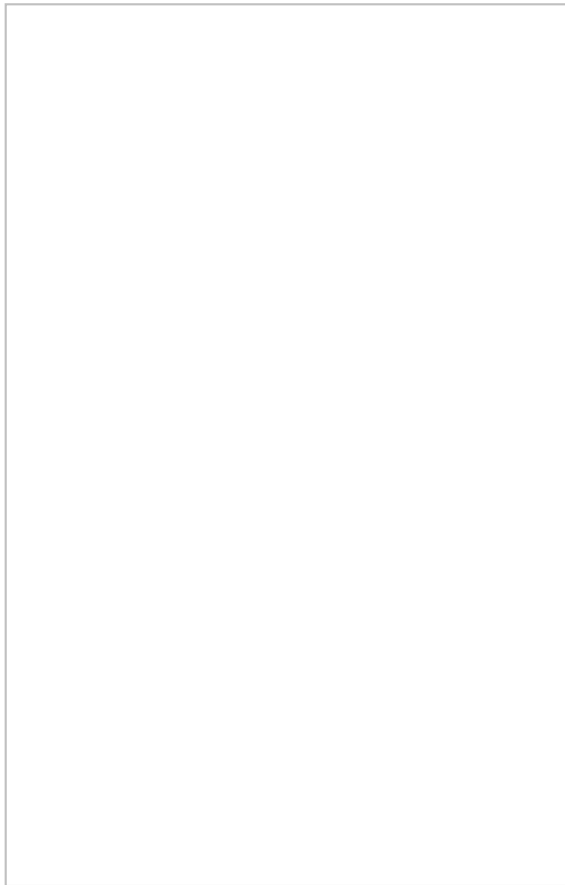
### 1) Global Connections - Toast Masters & Greek National Day Celebrations
