## 4) TAX FACTS – What is FNTR?

As in past years, we will soon be selling passwords for \$2 for you to be able to access a tax preparation software program. The password will be available around mid-February. This software makes it easy for nonresident aliens (which is what the IRS calls international students and scholars) to prepare their tax returns.

**FNTR** is an acronym for Foreign National Tax Resource. **FNTR** is a web-based tax return preparation system designed exclusively for foreign students, scholars, teachers, researchers, trainees, and their dependents who are nonresident aliens to aid in preparing U.S. federal income tax Forms 1040NR and 1040NR-EZ.



Please review this newsletter each week for more tips on filing your taxes. You will be soon receiving your W-2 forms and/or within the next thirty days, you may receive a 1042S. Save any and all of these tax-related documents to use in preparing your 2011 tax forms for the IRS.
