4) Health Insurance Waiver Deadline

Fall Semester deadline for insurance waiver is **September 7, 2012.**

Waivers will be approved only for students who have a U.S. based insurance coverage through the employer of a spouse or parent or students or are sponsored by the government.

Sponsored students should submit financial guarantees to **Cathy Moore in the Bursar's office on or before September 7, 2012** and dependent waiver requests should be sent to Nycia Bolds in University Center for International Education (UCIE Office).

You must immediately verify in Wings Express that items on your bill are correct and request a waiver if corrections are needed or you will be required to pay for any unchallenged fees after September 7th.

Below are several other eligibility requirements as specified below:

- A. Must be on a student visa; and in valid visa status
- B. Must maintain a minimum 3.0 g.p.a. (cum.) for undergraduate students or 3.25 g.p.a. (cum.) for graduate students
- C. Must have been enrolled at Wright State University for a minimum of two terms prior to Fall Semester 2012
- D. Must have demonstrated financial need
- E. Must be eligible to use scholarship funds toward tuition during the 2012-2013 academic year
- F. Must not be receiving a graduate assistantship or tuition waiver for the selected academic term
