1) Job Opening at UCIE

UCIE is in need of drivers and country reps for the upcoming winter break.

This will be an opportunity for you to meet new international students from different countries and also share your experience with the new incoming students.

You must be available from 12/6/12 thru 12/18/12 and registered full time for spring classes.

Job title: Arrival Welcome Assistant & Drivers (drivers 21 years old and up)

Job Description:

Work as a member of a team (pairs of two student workers), to pickup new international students using a university vehicle (van) as the students arrive at the Dayton International Airport during the semester break periods.

Job Requirements:

"Drivers 21yr +" have a good driving record and be approved through the WSU Risk Management. Country reps should have good intercultural skills. Sorry no LEAP Students.

Pay: \$7.80

Hours/Week: 5-8hrs

Application Instructions:

Submit letter of interest and resume (and drivers license copy if for driver position) or for "country rep" submit resume and letter of description of experience with other cultures/languages & WSU student activities at E190 SU (UCIE Office) or send it to ucie4@wright.edu ASAP.





2) Travelling During the Break

Those choosing to travel outside the US between Fall and Spring semester should turn in a request for a Travel Signature ASAP. Please submit the request form along with your I-20/DS-2019 at the front desk.

Delaying this process will put you at risk of not obtaining a travel signature before you leave for your trip. ****It takes about 5 - 7 business days to process a travel signature.****

*Please be reminded that each travel signature is good for 1 year, so if you have a signature on your I-20 that is less than 1 year old, you do not need a new one.



3) Attn: Students considering enrolling for classes in other universities

Please be aware that students on F-1 visa, **may enroll in only ONE “online class” per semester.**

This is an immigration regulation which must be complied with even if you are taking classes at university other than Wright State as a transient student.
