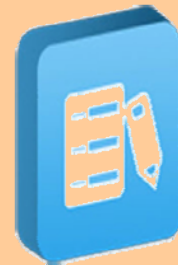

**Fall Semester deadline** for insurance waiver is **Wednesday, September 4, 2013.**

Waivers will be approved only for students who have a U.S. based insurance coverage through the employer of a spouse or parent or students who are sponsored by the government.
