5) Registration HOLDS on Student Accounts

Summer 2014 and Fall 2014 registrations have begun. If you are unable to register for classes, it could be because you have a hold placed on your student account, which will prevent you from registering for classes.

A hold may be placed on your account from any department on campus for various reasons. To see if you currently have any holds preventing you from registering for classes, log in to your <u>WINGS Express</u> account:



- Click on "Student and Financial Aid"
- Click on "Registration & Records"
- Click on "View Holds"

The "View Holds" page will let you view your active holds and which departments placed those holds so that you can begin taking proactive steps towards fulfilling the requirements.
