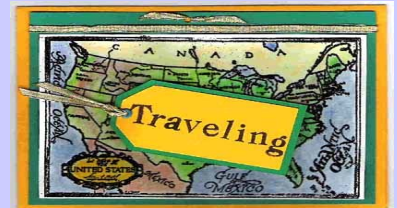
3) Update Phone Numbers: Important Announcement:
