#### 6) An Open Immigration Advising Session with Kim Fritz and Kim Brumbaugh



When: Tuesday - 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. Thursday - 3 p.m. to 4 p.m.








#### 7) Available Scholarships for International Students

### P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship Fund


The P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship Fund provides scholarships for selected international women for graduate study in the United States and Canada.



Will be working toward a full-time graduate degree in an accredited university or college in the United States or Canada ■ Will be enrolled and in residence for the entire school year of the scholarship Promise to return to their countries within 60 days of completion of their degree to pursue their professional career

- Maximum of \$10,000 annually, depending on need
- May be renewed once
