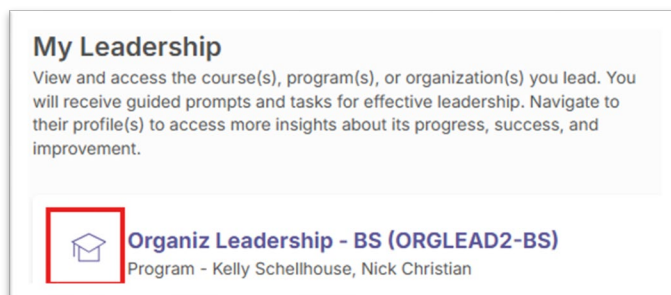


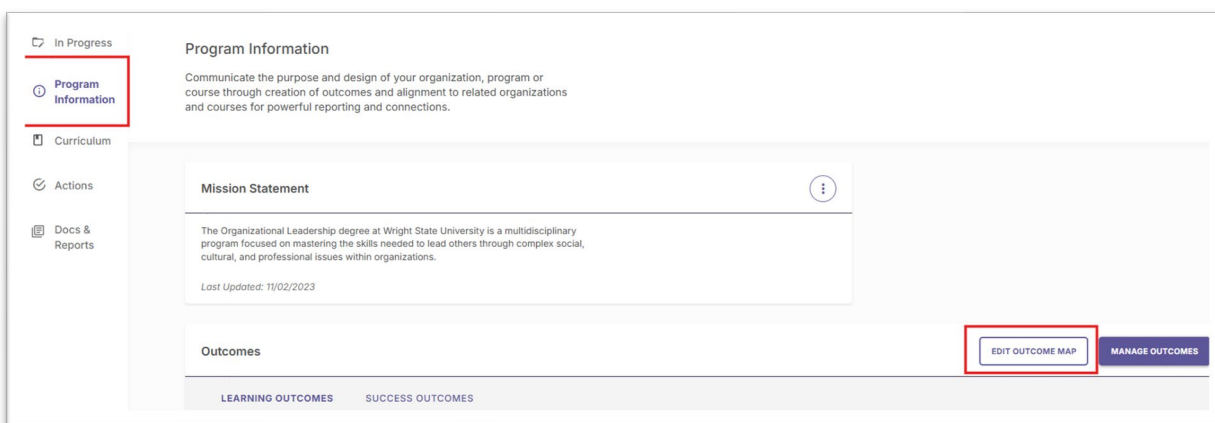
## Mapping Program to Institutional Learning Outcomes

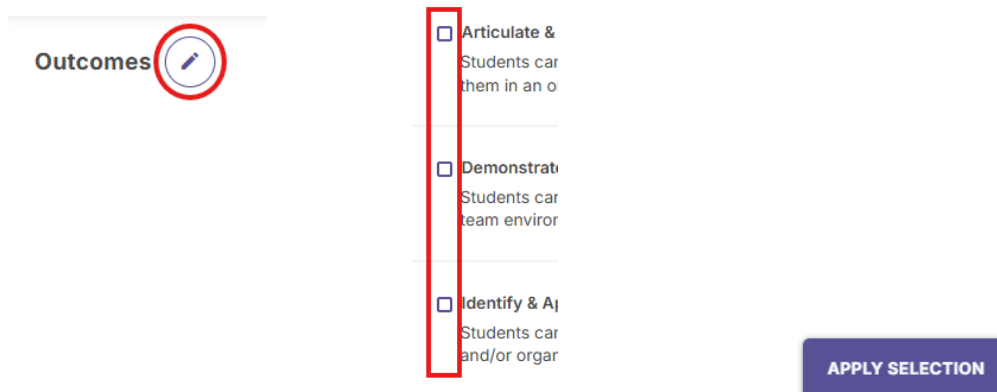
Those assigned as assessment leads at the program level can map program learning outcomes (PLO) to institutional learning outcomes (ILO). To begin, navigate to the program under “My Leadership.” Programs are designated by the mortar board icon and will say “Program” under the name.



Once in the program, choose “Program Information” on the left-side menu of options, then look for the “Edit Outcome Map” toward the right.



If no outcomes appear, click the pencil icon beside “Outcomes” in the top left to choose your program outcomes to map. Mark the current outcomes using the checkboxes in front of your current outcomes and click “Apply Selection” in the top right.



## Map Program Learning Outcomes

To align a PLO to an ILO, click on the cell where the PLO intersects with the Institution.

On the right side of the screen, a panel with the ILOs will appear. Select the checkboxes for any ILO that requires mapping to the corresponding PLO on the map. The corresponding square will change from a “+” to a checkmark when mapped. Choose another cell from the middle of the screen to continue mapping. When done mapping, click the “Close” button in the top left.
