- ☐ 3. Otherwise qualified under Instructional Professional standards (AACSB as currently adopted by RSCOB and incorporated by reference) with a minimum of three activities listed below within the previous three years:
 - ☐ Member of a business or professionally oriented board closely related to the field of international business
 - ☐ Acquisition or maintenance of relevant professional certification or warrants
 - ☐ Development, presentation, or completion of continuing professional education courses in the fields of international business.
 - ☐ Consulting or publishing in areas relevant to project management, contracting, negotiation, and conflict resolution
 - ☐ Playing a significant role within an enterprise that sells internationally
 - ☐ Successful performance of similar professional related activities
