Who Qualifies?

Any Motion Pictures major who

- 1) is a senior
- 2) has a cumulative grade point of 3.5 in the major
- 3) has an overall grade point of 3.25
- 4) has finished the film history sequence and three history/theory courses

Where, When, and How to Apply

- 1) Get an application from the coordinator of Motion Pictures, who will discuss your project with you
- 2) Apply at least one semester before the semester in which you wish to do your project
- 3) Start thinking about your project during your junior year

The Honors Project

- 1) is completed under MP-4990, for 3 or 4 credits for one semester
- 2) is evaluated by the Motion Pictures faculty
- 3) must reflect the student's own thinking and/or independent research and represent an attempt to explore some area of film history, theory, criticism, or practice, of special concern to the student
- 4) must not replicate materials or opportunities available from departmental classes
- 5) may have two options for its final form: a paper or a production

The Honors Degree

will be conferred upon successful completion of the Honors project.
