## School of Social Sciences and International Studies/Master of Public Administration: Alternate Criteria for Graduate Faculty Status

The chair in the School of Social Sciences and International Studies (SoSSIS) and affiliated program faculty in the Master of Public Administration program have developed the following criterial for part-time adjunct faculty and instructors who do not hold a terminal degree and/or may not have publications to teach the specified courses.

Alternate Criteria:
1. Have or currently hold a master's degree in geography, political science, public administration, criminal justice, sociology, or a related field from an accredited university.
2. Have a minimum of three years of experience in the relevant field of study.
3. Candidates submit a transcript and resume documenting their qualifications.
4. Candidate demonstrates ability to teach graduate students effectively through:
a Previous university and graduate teaching experience
b No previous teaching experience but the candidate has been assigned a faculty mentor to help with course preparation and pedagogy.
