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REQUEST FOR IN-STATE TUITION STATUS UNDER OHIO SENATE BILL 53

Students who live in a contiguous state and who are gainfully employed in Ohio by a business or government agency located in Ohio, may qualify for in-state tuition when the employer enters into a contract with Wright State University to pay all of the student's tuition and fees directly to the institution for specific classes without seeking reimbursement from the student in any manner.

Students applying for in-state tuition under this rule should complete this form and submit an official letter on letterhead from the employer verifying employment status and stating that they agree to enter into such a contract with Wright State University.

Note: Students who register for additional classes, which are not included in the employer's contract with the university, will be charged out-of-state fees for those classes.

Applications must be received no later than the first week of regular term or day two of a short tem.
