1. ADMISSIONS AND DEADLINES

Join the Wright Path Program

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at wright.edu/wrightpath/sinclair.

High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Sinclair College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Sinclair College in order to transfer to Wright State. To be admitted into the Health and Physical Education Program at Wright State, students must earn a minimum 2.6 GPA from Sinclair College.

Students must apply for the Health and Physical Education program by January 15 of the junior year/year three. Additionally, students must apply for field experience, HPR 3100 Practicum I at Wright State, by January 15 of junior year/year three.

All students with declared Health and Physical Education major are automatically admitted as Pre-Health and Physical Education students.

In addition to the above requirements, the following criteria are required for full admission into the program:

- 30 semester hours of college coursework
- Completion of first aid program, concussion course, CPR certification. See details regarding approved trainings at <https://health-education-human-services.wright.edu/nursing-kinesiology-and-health-sciences/bachelor-of-science-in-education-in-health-and-physical-education>.

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- Interview with faculty member who will complete Candidate Dispositional Assessment: Candidate Disposition Inventory (CDI) (PDF)


