- Students are required to begin their Wright State program in fall term of the junior year/year three.
- Students must apply for admission to Wright State **and** the Middle Childhood Education program by January 15 of the sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Sinclair). Additionally, students must apply for field experience, ED 2650 Field Experience I at Wright State, by January 15 of sophomore year/year two.

*Note that students must apply and be admitted to the university before Middle Childhood Education Program and field applications can be approved.

- In addition to submitting the program application, the following criteria are required for full admission into the Middle Childhood Education program:
 - Cumulative minimum GPA of 2.6
 - A minimum of 60 semester hours (including in-progress courses)
 - Grade of C or higher in each of the following:
 - All Pre-Professional Core courses: MAT 1510 or 2415 and SOC 2210 at Sinclair

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- Any equivalent transfer courses and Wright State courses that are applicable to the Wright State Core Requirements that are related to the students' two respective concentration areas (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies)
- All Teacher Education courses: EDU 1100, EDU 1105, and PSY 2242 at Sinclair
- Passing scores in each of the following areas:
 - One of the following reading scores:
 - ACT reading score of 19 or better
 - SAT evidence-based reading and writing score of 520 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators reading score of 162 or better
 - One of the following writing scores:
 - ACT writing score of 6 or better
 - SAT writing dimension score of 5 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators writing score of 165 or better
 - One of the following math scores:
 - ACT math score of 17 or better
 - SAT math score of 510 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators math score of 158 or better
- Consult with your dedicated Wright State academic advisor about the program application process and deadlines.
- Note that MAT 2415 and 2435 replaced MAT 1510 and 1520 effective fall 2022 and spring 2023.
- Students selecting Mathematics Concentration will need to either complete MTH 1280 College Algebra (or MAT 1470 at Sinclair) or place out of the course via Wright State's placement test or equivalent (e.g., ALEKS score of 61 or higher) in order to register for MTH 3430 Algebra and Functions for Middle School Teachers. Consult with Wright State academic advisor.
- 135-144 hours minimum are required for a BSED degree in Middle Childhood Education at Wright State.

High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Sinclair College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Sinclair College in order to transfer to Wright State. To be admitted into the Middle Childhood Education Program at Wright State, students must earn a minimum 2.6 GPA from Sinclair College.

Students must apply for admission to Wright State and the Middle Childhood Education program by January 15 of the sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Sinclair). Additionally, students must apply for field experience, ED 2650 Field Experience I at Wright State, by January 15 of sophomore year/year two.

*Note that students must apply and be admitted to the university before Middle Childhood Education Program and field applications can be approved.

Students are required to begin their Wright State program in fall term of the junior year/year three.

In addition to submitting the program application, the following criteria are required for full admission into the Middle Childhood Education program:

- Cumulative minimum GPA of 2.6
- A minimum of 60 semester hours (including in-progress courses)
- Grade of C or higher in each of the following:
 - All Pre-Professional Core courses: MAT 1510 or 2415 and SOC 2210 at Sinclair
 - Any equivalent transfer courses and Wright State courses that are applicable to the Wright State Core Requirements that are related to the students' two respective concentration areas (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies)
 - All Teacher Education courses completed: EDU 1100, EDU 1105, and PSY 2242 at Sinclair
- Passing scores in each of the following areas:
 - One of the following reading scores:
 - ACT reading score of 19 or better
 - SAT evidence-based reading and writing score of 520 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators reading score of 162 or better
 - One of the following writing scores:
 - ACT writing score of 6 or better
 - SAT writing dimension score of 5 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators writing score of 165 or better
 - One of the following math scores:
 - ACT math score of 17 or better
 - SAT math score of 510 or better
 - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators math score of 158 or better
