- All students with interest in music must complete a School of Fine and Performing Arts application for an audition at the time of transferring to Wright State, perform a satisfactory audition in a major performance area, and meet with an assigned advisor from the music faculty for counseling and registration.
- All students with declared Music major are automatically admitted as Pre-Music students. In order to be admitted fully as a BM major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 in all music courses and an overall cumulative GPA of 2.7.
- All students in music education will meet with the Coordinator of Music Education to determine if they are ready to begin the Instrumental Methods sequence. If this is the case, they will be permitted to register for the fall semester Instrumental Methods course and will have that

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semester to complete their Sophomore Music Education Board. Sophomore Music Education Board must be completed in order to register for ED 2650 Early Field Experience I at Wright State in their junior year/year three. Consult with the Coordinator of Music Education for detailed information.

- Students with Piano or Organ focus will complete MUS 1119 (Secondary Voice) at Sinclair and be waived of MUS 1550 and 1560 Keyboard Musicianship I and II based on their completed applied piano or organ courses.
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1101 at Sinclair College.
- 122-127 hours minimum are required for a BM degree at Wright State.

High school students must be close to graduating before applying to the Wright Path, and current Sinclair College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Sinclair College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

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Fall Semester: **April 1**
Spring Semester: **October 15**
Summer Semester: **February 1**

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All students with declared Music major are automatically admitted as Pre-Music students. In order to be admitted fully as a BM major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 in all music courses and an overall cumulative GPA of 2.7.

All students in music education will meet with the Coordinator of Music Education to determine if they are ready to begin the Instrumental Methods sequence. Students with Piano or Organ focus will complete MUS 1119 (Secondary Voice) at Sinclair and be waived of MUS 1550 and 1560 Keyboard Musicianship I and II based on their completed applied piano or organ courses.

Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1101 at Sinclair College.
