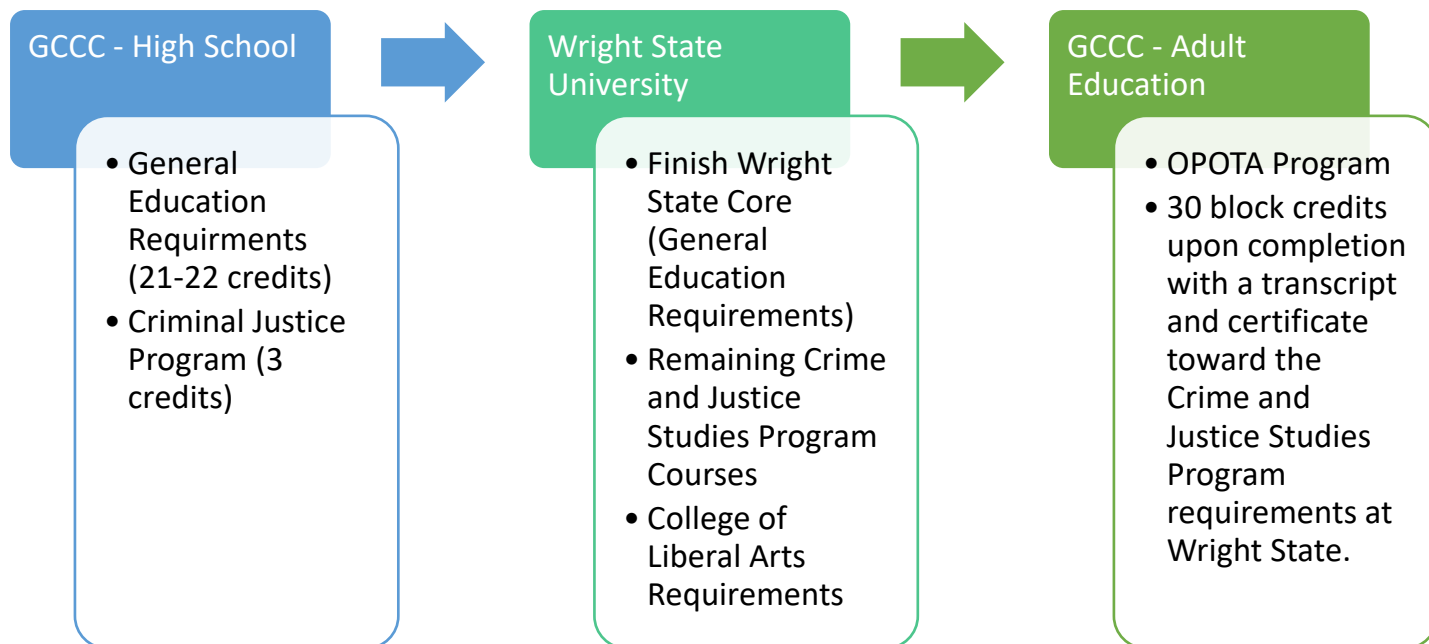


GCCC has worked with Wright State to create an agreement that aligns and awards coursework for a Bachelor of Arts degree in Crime and Justice Studies Program.


