- Enjoy at least 1 visit to an American home (i.e. celebrate American holidays, birthday celebration, and/or a meal).

What is not expected of me?

- Attending events that conflict with your schedule.
- Attending any event that makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Asking for housing. Please note this is not a live in host family program. Your host family is only expected to host you for at least one event in their home (i.e. to celebrate an American holidays, birthday celebration, and/or share a meal).
- Asking for financial assistance. Your host family is not expected to help you financially in any way.
- Asking for academic support. Your host family is not expected to tutor you. If you need any support, please contact the UCIE office.
- Asking for transportation. Your host family is not expected to provide transportation, but they may be willing. UCIE is able to help with transportation if needed.
