Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

- 1. Minutes from November 6, 2015 Buildings and Grounds Committee were approved as long as the following additions are made:
 - a. Include a statement on unsafe conditions of concrete walkways at some locations on campus.
 - b. Include a statem saying that one person has been hurt by these unsafe walkways.
 - c. Include a statement that these unsafe walkways are a problem for people in wheelchairs.

Capital Plan Money

- 1. Dr. Menart presented a comparison of the original Capital Plan, the Buildings and Grounds changes to the original Capital Plan, and the final Capital Plan put forth by the University administration to the committee. This document is attached.
- 2. Some of the recommendations of the Buildings and Grounds committee were implemented by the administration.



3. It was guessed that we may get \$13 million dollars from the state in Capital Plan money, and thus five or six of the 2017-2018 biennium projects may be funded.

University Master Plan

- 1. Dr. Menart discussed the issue of the Master Plan because of all the complaints that have been coming into the Faculty Senate about the Master Plan.
- 2. Dr. Menart presented these complaints to the committee.
- 3. Dr. Menart recommended that the Buildings and Grounds Committee present a resolution to the Faculty Senate about the Master Plan.
 - a. The proposal by Dr. Menart was to have the Faculty Senate ask the administration to remove the \$5 million line item from the Capital Plan 2019-2020 biennium budget and the \$7 million line item from the Capital Plan 2021-2022 biennium budget allocated for the Facility Master Plan.
 - b. Doing this sends a message to the Administration that there is a great deal of concern and doubt about the logic of the 2015 Wright State Facility Master Plan.
 - c. No work on the Master Plan should proceed without the consent of the Faculty Senate.
 - d. The proposed destruction of 8 facilities (12 buildings) by the Master Plan is not a prudent way for the University to proceed.
 - e. The Buildings and Grounds Committee was in favor of Dr. Menart's proposal
 - f. Dr. Menart should write-up a formal resolution.
