- a) HR/CSAC/USAC Chair meeting 5/10/17 Jennifer Kostic, Talent Manager, Human Resources, met Tom Fortener and Carol Alexander (filling in for Ryan Fullenkamp) of CSAC and Jerry Hensley and Amanda Spencer of USAC (supposed to be chair and chair-elect of respective committees) to explain the termination process. The main emphasis was that Ms. Kostic was checking other business's HR websites to find jobs that might match the WSU displaced employees' job skills. Human Resources will then have a job page on the HR website detailing the job postings, and will also host a job fair at the end of June, that will be open to all employees. HR will provide Career Transition Resources, including resume assistance and mock interviews. The push for providing these resources came from Board of Trustees member Doug Fecher. Process of notification Supervisor will set up a meeting with the employee, then the employee meets with their dean or VP and HR Business Partner. The employee is allowed to have another person in the meeting if they desire.
- b) June 1st, Tom Fortener and Carol Alexander will review the comments HR receives regarding the abolishment of classified staff's "bumping rights".
