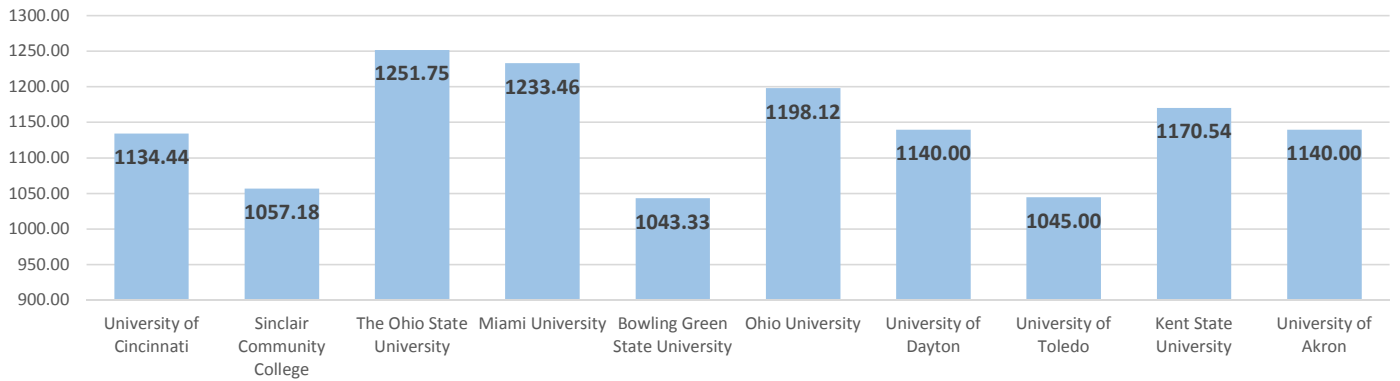

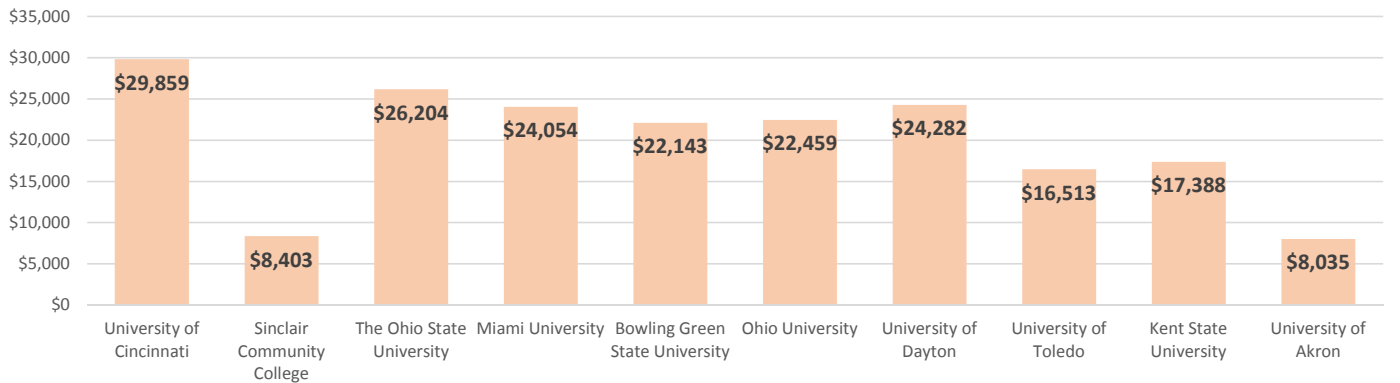

Average SAT

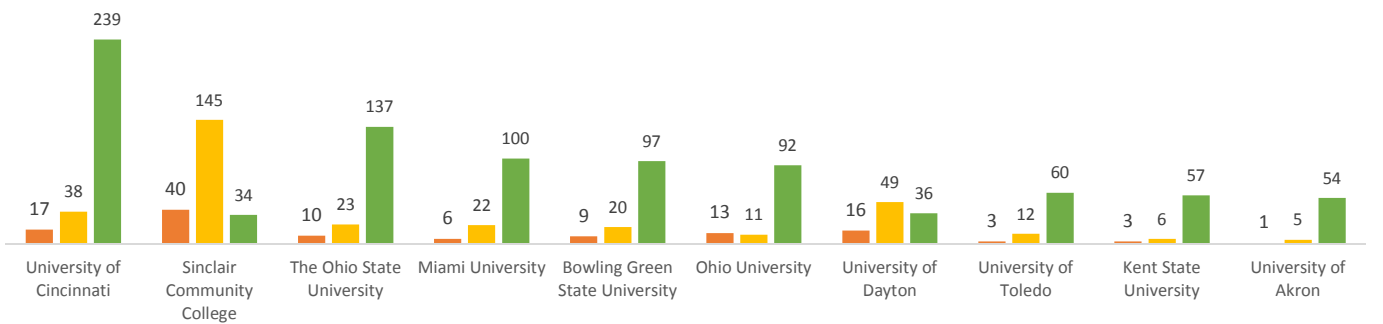


Average EFC
