SUBJECT: Faculty Senate Special Election: Faculty Vice President (2019-21)

On July 19, 2019, Dan Krane announced he was resigning as Faculty President to serve as the interim Dean of the Lake Campus. Effective August 1, 2019, per Faculty Constitution Article II Section 3.A.2.e, Faculty Vice President Laura Luehrmann became the Faculty President and will serve in that position through the April 2021 Faculty Senate meeting.

A special election is now required to fill the vacant position of Faculty Vice President. The successful candidate will serve upon election through the April 2021 Faculty Senate meeting. Nominations can be made using the form linked below or by emailing the Faculty Senate Office. Nominees will be required to submit a vita, which will be supplied to the Faculty as part of the election procedures, by 12:00pm, Friday, October 4 in order to appear on the ballot.
