Significant Policy Accomplishments for Academic Year

The UAPC was able to complete a significant number of new policy creations and modifications, most of which have already been passed or are currently being considered by the Senate. These include the following:

Modifications to 3110, Undergraduate Degree Seeking Admissions, and creation of 3120, Non-Degree Seeking Admissions- These admissions changes were part of a major overhaul of Admissions polies that have taken place over the past few years. The revised policies largely reflect current admissions practices in the Admissions Department and UCIE.

<u>Modifications to 3640, Graduation with Latin Honors</u>- Discussions focused on the issues of how to consider transfer credit and course repeats (including Fresh Start) for calculations of Latin Honors in a manner that is consistently equitable to all groups of students.

<u>Modifications to 3215, Transfer Credit Regulations</u>- allowing for the evaluation of earned credit from Non-CHEA institutions, as recommended by the ODHE Chancellor.

<u>Modifications to 3660, Posthumous Degree Policy</u>- To clarify the application and petitions process, and to establish standards for a Certificate of Recognition where needed.

<u>Modifications to 3630 Multiple Degree Policy</u>- to clarify the recognition of completion of, and smooth transition to 4 + 1 programs.

<u>Merger of 3680 and 3685, Graduation Application and Commencement Participation</u>- To streamline policies, and insert information relevant to Lake Campus commencement participants.
