The space has fallen into a state of disrepair and close to no longer being HPPA compliant. As a part of the School of Medicine's long term plan to move units back close to campus the Department of Psychiatry is relocating to 2555 University Blvd, a building owned by Double Bowler Properties. The WSU Facilities Planning Team has developed the space plan for the relocation and Double Bowler has solicited bids for the work. This transaction will directly reimburse Double Bowler for the work. There is no markup on the project expenses.</p>
