
Wright State University has recorded 177 awards totaling \$48,304,526 in external funding for the time period of July 1, 2020 – December 31, 2020.

Recent funding received by the University includes a combined total of \$172,180 from Butler, Champaign, Miami, Preble, and Warren County General Health Districts to Dr. Marietta Orlowski (Department of Population and Public Health Sciences) to hire students to provide case investigation and COVID-19 contact tracing for those Health Departments.
