Wright State University has recorded 218 awards totaling \$48,225,003.43 in external funding for the time period of July 1, 2022 – March 31, 2023.

Recent funding received by the University includes \$174,943 from the National Science Foundation to Dr. Lingwei Chen in the Computer Science & Engineering Department, to explore leveraging machine learning to detect security attacks from a more practical perspective with the labeled data being limited and/or imbalanced, where the proposed solutions can still deliver the promising detection performance in a learning-effective yet cost-efficient manner.




