SGA Resolution In Support of the Student First Fund Application

WHEREAS, the Wright State University Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and

WHEREAS, Wright State University has many students who may not have adequate access to clothing items and steady income; and

WHEREAS, lack of financial support has been a major reason why students nation-wide drop out of college; and

WHEREAS, The raid-our-closet campus resource specializes specifically in business & interview clothing; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists no other clothing resources for students on campus who are in need of winter clothes, scrubs, maternity & baby clothes, athletic wear, caps & gowns, and casual everyday clothes; therefore an all-encompassing clothing resource to be added to the campuses resource would be beneficial; and

WHEREAS, There is shortage of volunteering opportunities on campus and a new donation-based student-run resource can be a positive community building experience for the campus; and

WHEREAS, The new all-encompassing clothing closet resource needs to be approved of by faculty for an allotted space and a small amount of beginner funds to be initially created and self-sustaining in the future; so be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association recommends that a fund be put aside to allow for a student run program which provides low cost clothing items for students; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association is in support of attempts to create a free donation-based clothing closet resource on campus
