

Core Implementation Plan – Draft
(Reviewed by EC Jan 17th)

When the Core Policy gets voted and approved to reflect the core resolution that was approved in December the following will be the implementation plan to move to the new core.

Current Core Courses:

Process for moving the current core courses to the new core – Expedited for transition:

- Programs will use a new form “Core transition form” in curriculog to make the transitions.
- The form will require/allow only the following:
 - Changing of learning outcomes and course objectives to meet the new core outcomes.
 - Request for the core element.
 - Include provision to attach OT 36 application.
- The curriculog proposal steps are the following:

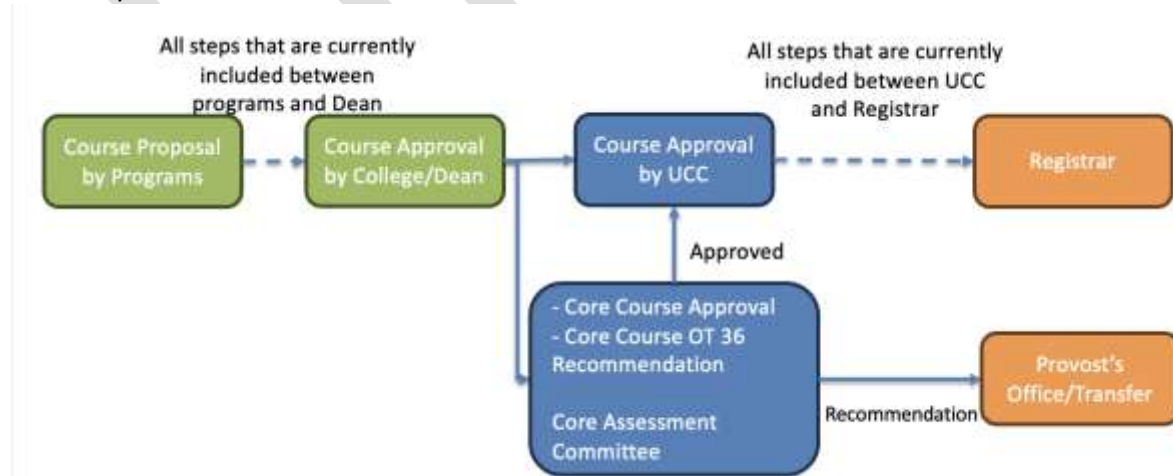


- The senate special committee is expected to meet over summer to get the A-E core transition completed, as are programs and colleges if they want the courses to be considered in the A-E Core.
- All course approvals must complete the curriculog proposal by August 1, 2024

New Core Course Proposals:

- If an existing course is applying to be considered in the core, they will go through the regular course modification approval process (which will now include core approval step)
- If a new course is applying to be considered in the core, they will go through the regular new course approval process (which will now include core approval step).

The new regular core approval process is the following, specifically highlighting the steps at the university level:



Program Changes

- Programs can make changes to reflect the new core starting Aug 1st
- All programs will need to move to the new core Fall '25
