- March Enrollment Management Speakers with Susan Schauer, VP Enrollment Management (see slideshow)
 - Jen McCamis, Associate Vice President, Enrollment Management Division and Undergraduate Admissions
 - Applications for New/Direct up 16.7% from FA24 to FA25; Admits up 25.1% from FA24 to FA25 (Dayton Campus); -4.4% applications and 7.25% admits for Lake Campus
 - Working to increase brand awareness across the state in addition to Raider Country
 - Application days at area high schools
 - Students that are applying are very interested in Wright State; increase in number of students completing their application
 - Statement of Intent, FAFSA completion, housing applications being promoted for completion
 - New events including Green and Gold to engage admitted students; more scheduled for spring
 - Wright.edu/admit
 - Orientation dates announced; students can be registered at orientation
 - FAFSA seems to be working better than last year; ahead in new student FAFSA's but decline in continuing student completion – encourage students (especially veterans) to complete it especially for those already utilizing financial aid; need based packages have already started to be sent and will be on rolling basis
 - Pell Grants have been funded
 - o Hideo Tsuchida, Director for Articulation, Transfer and Institutional Partnerships
 - Transfer applications up 14.1% and 25.8% admits for Dayton Campus;
 69.4% up for applications and 36.4% admits for Lake Campus; still expecting more;
 97% of applications are admitted
 - Active Duty Undergraduate Tuition Scholarship help us be more competitive with other schools
 - Must be eligible; Tuition Assistance (TA) benefit is lower than Wright State cost; scholarships will help close the financial gap, has some fees/costs exclusions

- Has had several people championing the creation of this scholarship

 - Career Hub new space is open in Student Union, 1st floor (SU108)
 - Headshots photo booth available to staff as well as students
 - Multiple spaces within the Hub; 5700 sq ft (former Pathfinder Lounge and other meeting spaces)
 - Employers visiting campus utilizing the spaces
 - Students can reserve spaces to use for online interviews, etc. reservations done internally to Career Services
 - Alumni served free for life
