<u>Proposal</u>	<u>Type</u>
Instructional Design for Digital Learning-1, Graduate Certificate	<u>Program Termination</u> - The certificate is no longer needed as most students have completed their master's degree. Therefore, the certificate program was not needed. The program was paused several years ago. Students were given a completion plan, so any certificate students have finished their certificate program.
Instructional Design for Digital Learning-2, Graduate Certificate	<u>Program termination</u> - The students in our program were finishing their master's degree. Therefore, this certificate was no longer needed. The certificate was put on hold a few years ago. Students that were in the program finished their certificates.
International Relations, MA (INTLCMPOL-MA)	<p>Program Modification</p> <p>Change name of Program to better reflect market norms and appeal</p> <p>Reduce required elective courses from 5 to 4 (research track) and from 7 to 6 (exam track) to reduced total hours needed, keeping the 30-hour minimum intact. Makes program more cost-effective, competitive and attractive</p>
